

Estonia—The role of external funding for infrastructure

Project appraisal procedures

External funding	Domestic funding
Same principles for all sectors + sectorial specifications	Principles depending on sector
Principles established by legislation	Some principles established by legislation
Appraisal by experts	 Appraisal on different levels: line ministry line ministry + coordinating ministry

▶ Different pipelines, but some projects may occur in both

Estonia—The role of external funding for infrastructure

Project selection procedures

External funding	Domestic funding
Transparent procedure and ranking system	 Each ministry has his own (but not always a stringent set of) selection criteria
Procedure and criteria established by legislation	 Some guidelines established by legislation
Selection by experts	 Selection depending on financing: line ministry coordinating ministry + government
Only apprised projects can be selected	 Unapproved projects can be selected

Estonia—Managing Capital Budgeting

Issue

- External funding can result in "dual" capital budgeting
 - Project appraisal and selection criteria different for domestically and externally funded projects
 - ▶ Two different pipeline of projects competing for budget sources

Reform efforts

- Apply standard appraisal methodology to all investment projects
- Formalize criteria for project selection
- Maintain an integrated project pipeline
